

## Athletic Program Participation and Completion Rates (For Academic Year 2022)

As part of the Equity in Athletics Disclosure Act (EADA), Our Lady of the Lake University is required to produce an annual report with enrollment and completion rates and disclose this information to students, prospective students and the public in easily accessible places.

The information is presented in the following way:

- The number of male and female full-time undergraduate students that attended the school. (TABLE 1)
- The total amount and ratio of athletically related student aid awarded to male athletes compared to female athletes. (TABLE 2)
- The expenses incurred by the school for men's and women's sports. (TABLE 3)
- The total annual revenues for men's or women's sports. (TABLE 4)
- The annual school salary of non-volunteer head coaches and assistant coaches for men's and women's teams. (TABLE 5)
- For each varsity team in intercollegiate competition, the number and gender of participants and coaches, operating expenses, etc. (TABLE 6 and 7)
- The number of students, categorized by race and gender, who attended the school in the year prior. (TABLE 8)
- The number of students who received athletically related student aid, categorized by race and gender within each sport. (TABLES 9 and 10)
- The completion or graduation rate and, if applicable, transfer out rate<sup>1</sup> of all entering, certificate- or degree-seeking, full-time undergraduate students described in 34 CFR §668.45(a) (1), categorized by race and gender. (TABLE 11)
- The average completion or graduation rate and, if applicable, transfer out for the four most recent completing or graduating classes of entering students described in §668.45(a) (1), (3)m and (4), categorized by race and gender. (TABLE 12)
- The average completion or graduation rate and, if applicable, transfer-out rate of the four most recent completing or graduating classes of entering students described in §668.45 (a)(1) who received athletically related student aid, categorized by race and gender within each sport. If a school has rates for fewer than four of those classes, it must disclose the rates it has. (TABLE 13)

Other student aid, of which a student-athlete simply happens to be the recipient, is not athletically related student aid.
