As stated previously, this will be a national search that will employ a competitive, integrity-driven, transparent and objective process.

The full position description was created through an inclusive process with the participation of Faculty Assembly leadership. This week, the chairs are finalizing a summary of the position description and will be working with Human Resources to have the opportunity posted through our internal system and through various higher education publications.
