## **More online/remote instruction options available in fall, but in-person classes still offered**

The health and safety of the OLLU community continues to be our top priority. To help safeguard our community and in response to the recent directive on schools by the City of San Antonio, OLLU will be making more online/remote classes available; however, in order to meet your preferred learning style as best as possible, some face-to-face and hybrid course options are still available.

The course schedule is currently being updated. Look for an email notification about the schedule update on or before July 28.

### **Campus services available in-person and remotely**
