It is the policy of OLLU to provide amnesty for any student who in good faith reports sexual violence, or for any student witness who is participating in an investigation related to sexual violence. OLLU shall not sanction the student for a conduct violation, such as underage drinking, that is revealed in the course of such a report or investigation involving sexual violence.

Submitting a report does not require you to pursue a complete investigation. We can assist in many ways including obtaining a no-contact order, making classroom or housing adjustments, and accessing on- and off-campus resources.
