



PROGRAM OUTCOMES

The Woolfolk School of Communication Sciences and Disorders annually examines student outcomes by collecting data to determine the percentage of students completing the program within the expected time frame, the percentage of students that pass the Praxis examination on first attempt, and the percentage of graduates who are gainfully employed in the profession one year after graduation.
